### **Product Release**

- Q. Is the new 2007 Tundra available in a  $\frac{3}{4}$  or 1 Ton configuration?
- A. The new 2007 Tundra is available as a  $\frac{1}{2}$  ton category vehicle. Toyota is continuing to study opportunities in the full-size pick up market but has no information to share at this time regarding  $\frac{3}{4}$  or 1 ton configurations. ### **Warranty**

- Q. If not available as an option, what happens to warranty when customers make modifications to their Toyota truck or install Non-Genuine Toyota Parts?
- A. Regarding modifications in general, where such conversion, modification, or installation of a non-Toyota part does not adversely affect the performance, reliability, or stability of the vehicle, the warranty on that vehicle remains in effect and such action does not, in and of itself, render the warranty of a part void. However, Non-Genuine Toyota Parts, or any damage or failures resulting from their use or installation, are not covered by any Toyota warranty.

### **Modifications**

Q. On the high mount stop light (CHMSL), is there a pigtail wire?

A. No.

Q. Is there a pre-wired trailer brake controller and pigtail to connect the trailer brakes?

A. Yes – there is an under dash wiring connector for the trailer brake controller and a pigtail to connect the wiring harness from the trailer brakes.

Q. Regarding information supplied to upfitters, will there be sufficient detail to determine if holes have been pre-punched (ex: hood for bug shields) or weld nuts installed by the factory (ex: frame for mounting running boards)?

A. The dimensional illustrations should call-out these key points. However, it is best to review a vehicle in person to see if these mounting opportunities will work for your products. Q. Is there a Snow Plow Prep option?
