Beginning with select 2020 Toyota models, all multimedia grades will feature Android Auto¹ compatibility. This feature allows Android™² users to minimize distraction and better connect with their mobile device while in the vehicle.

Similar to Apple CarPlay^{®3}, Android Auto integrates its mobile operating system with the vehicle’s Audio Multimedia touchscreen and buttons, allowing for convenient interaction with first-party Android apps like phone and Google Maps, as well as third-party apps like Spotify^{®4} and Waze^{®5}.

To use Android Auto in your Toyota vehicle, you will need:


- **Android mobile device**

HOW TO GET STARTED


1 Open the Google Play Store and download the Android Auto app.




2 Launch the Android Auto app, then tap **Get Started**.




3a Tap **Continue** to review the permission requests.



3b Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to make and manage phone calls.




3c Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to access your device’s location.




3d Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to send and view SMS messages.




3e Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to access your calendar.




3f Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to record audio.




3g Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to access your contacts.




4a Tap **Continue** to review the notification requests.




4b Tap **Allow** or **Deny** to allow Android Auto to access your notifications.




5 Review the terms and conditions, then tap **Continue**.



6 Tap **Turn On** to activate the autolaunch function.




7 Review the Google Assistant feature, then tap **Got It**.
