

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT THE TAKATA RECALL



WHAT IS THE TAKATA RECALL?

- The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) says there will be 65-70 million defective Takata airbag inflators recalled by 19 automakers by the end of 2019. This is the largest vehicle recall in U.S. history.
- As of December 2017, these dangerous airbag inflators are currently installed in approximately 34 million unrepaired vehicles. It's possible that you or someone you may know is driving an affected vehicle.



HOW DO YOU FIX YOUR AIRBAG?

- Using the free app, check your vehicle to see if it is affected.
- If the vehicle is affected, you can find a local dealer that can perform the FREE repair using the app.

WHY IS THIS IMPORTANT TO YOU?

- Sharp metal fragments could spray directly at the driver and passengers if these defective airbags deploy.
- 19 automakers are affected by this recall, and according to NHTSA, these incidents have tragically claimed over a dozen lives.
- This is an urgent safety recall and the repair is **FREE** and easy.



REACHING OWNERS OF OLDER VEHICLES IS ESPECIALLY IMPORTANT

- These defective airbags degrade over time, especially in areas of the country with high temperature fluctuation and high absolute humidity.
- As time passes without the vehicle being repaired, owners are at an increased risk of serious injury or even death.
